

Can **you** identify these celebrity **smiles**?



What sticks out right away is the red color of the gums which gives an unhealthy appearance to the Neutrogena Spokesperson. The individual teeth are very wide and a bit round. The front right tooth is darker than the front left tooth. This can be corrected with a bit of whitening, some gum therapy and possibly veneers to create fuller, longer teeth.

This is a beautiful looking smile for this "Bond girl." Though the back teeth are a bit dark this gives a little bit of a narrow appearance. To correct cosmetic veneers can be used to bring out the back teeth, and the slight overlap of the two front teeth can be resolved orthodontically.

This Greek babe dominates the screen with very prominent central incisors (front teeth). His "eye teeth" canines are very shark and pointed which makes his smile masculine looking. He should probably contour the (canines) for a softer appearance and whiten his smile a bit.

This former mouseketeer has a picture perfect grin – symmetrical, white, wide and very healthy. Sometimes a smile is all this teen diva needs to capture our hearts.

Beautiful vocals, but a horrid set of choppers. This talented country gal would look much more beautiful with a little help from her dentist. There are too many spaces, yellow teeth and an excessive gum display. This patient could be treated orthodontically with porcelain veneers and plastic gum surgery. Whitening would also make this rising star shine.

This smile can certainly "slay" any lucky guy! Perfectly white and symmetrical, this "vampy" seductress shouldn't change a thing.

We know what she did last summer. This young diva's smile is something to scream about. She has some tooth size and color discrepancies. In general, she might be a candidate for some plastic gum surgery and a little whitening. Some porcelain veneering may be necessary at the extreme.

My, what strong, sexy jaws this Latin sensation has! The better to bite with, girls... so watch out! His teeth are very straight and square, which give a macho masculine appearance. There is however a constricted jaw in the back teeth, especially on the right side, creating a "bulldog" look. This could be an orthodontic problem or a missing tooth problem.

Sorry to report that this "genie" needs much work to get that glam smile. There are obvious spaces, a bad rotation of the left canine tooth and a poor color of the same tooth. There are also some discrepancies in the gum heights. Dr. Roth strongly suggests orthodontics as a long term solution. However, plastic gum surgery and porcelain veneers would solve the problems more quickly.
